3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. To establish, promote, subsidize, encourage, provide, maintain, organise, undertake, manage, build, construct, equip, develop, recondition, operate, conduct and to run in India or abroad schools, colleges, boarding houses, ashrams, gurukuls, training centers, skill enhancement centres, computer classes, teaching classes for primary, secondary & higher education in the fields of commerce, arts, science, engineering, computer, medical, pharmacy, mining, military, music, dance, acting, sports, journalism, management, social welfare and industry which can be imparted to the students regularly orally or through post and to conduct examinations and to award degrees, certificates.

2. To help alleviate poverty by enabling access to the basic necessities of life including clean, safe and nutritious food; clean and safe drinking water; shelter; education; and livelihoods for people deprived from such access.

3. To provide opportunities to develop skills and talents of children and women with the aim of generating a sustainable income and be independent to march with the time and age.

4. To establish, build or manage Hostels, Short Stay Homes, Rehabilitation Centers, Shelters, Crches, Child Care Centre or Children Home, Counselling Centers and Help Line Centers for Women, Children, Old aged persons, Drug addicts and needy persons.

5. To conduct, manage, maintain and run health care centre, Health Centre, leprosy centres, Eye camps, Blood donation cam. Pulse polio drop distribution centre, vaccination camp, AIDs awareness and control programme, Cancer, Leprosy, Physical health education and training center, emergency medical and organizing for unemployed youth

6. To provide opportunities to develop skills and talents of children and women with the aim of generating a sustainable income and be independent to march with the time and age.

7. To raise awareness on environmental issues and push for changes in policy and development strategies for environmental monitoring; promoting environmental education, conducting seminars and workshops, training and capacity-building; implementing demonstration projects; conducting advocacy work in partnership with the government; and the promotion of regional and international cooperation on the environment

8. To promote social, cultural, religious activities intended for the general welfare of the public such as welfare of the destitute, family, women, children and the handicapped and assistance in cases of un-employment, under employment, old age, sickness, disablement and other cases of deserving needs.

9. To undertake CSR Projects and to carry on all those activities as mentioned in Schedule VII relevant to Section 135 of Companies Act, 2013.

10. To open special school for the blind, handicapped,

mentally disabled.
11. To establish Animals husbandry welfare wellbeing.

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

- 1) To organize promotion of physicals, mental, educational development and upliftment of all sections of society without any distinction of caste, creed or religion and in the interest of mankind in general.
- 2) To establish, promote, maintain, conduct and contribute to a) Educational Institutions or Scholarships for the spread of knowledge and to seminars, conferences, workshops, orientation or refresher programs for updating the knowledge for the persons engaged in the areas mentioned in nation to the aforesaid object.
b) Any legal competition and exhibition of works of Art or Interest, to grant prizes, rewards.
- 3) To award prizes in competition of physical games and educational standards and to awards Scholarships for the needy children or individuals and to increase moral discipline in them.
- 4) To establish, organize, run or maintain hospital, Nursing Home, Care and Care Centres, Medical education and research centre in state-of-art.
- 5) To establish, provide, start, run support and/or to maintain pyaooos, water heads, water booths or taps etc. for supplying and/or making available drinking and/or bathing water or facilities there of any/or for the use and benefit of the public in general.
- 6) To solicit and receive subscriptions, donations, endowments, gifts, movable or immovable, borrow, raise or secure payments for all or any of the objectives for which the Trust is established.
- 7) To provide literature, book, pamphlets, periodicals and newspapers in India or outside for the spread and advancement

of education and culture.

8) To provide fellowship, awards and title of honours to outstanding individuals in various fields to motivate them.

9) To undertake joint actions and network projects for the welfare and development of unprivileged, Depressed, downtrodden and disadvantaged group of communities.

10) To render social service activities, aimed at improving the conditions and standard of the students, and their general welfare, in urban and the rural areas through the Trust and in and in coordination with other NGOs whenever required.

11) To promote and encourage the physical education, moral education, health education, culture education and the interdisciplinary subjects for research and studies to the boys, girls, teachers of physical education for the development of good health and better citizenship.

12) To seek collaboration from renowned brands for schools, colleges and other professional and vocational institutions for quality education and instant recognition.

13) To provide equal opportunities for education to people from all strata of the society

14) To evolve systems of educational outreach programmes in rural and in urban areas where clusters of low-income groups exist.

15) To distribute free or concessional food and clothing to the poor.

16) And generally, to do other acts, deeds and things as maybe conducive to the attainment and furtherance of all or any of the above objects and purposes of the Foundation/or in any other way similar to them or relating thereto for the benefit of general public.

17) To bear all cost and/or other expenses incurred in connection

with incorporation of the Company including preliminary expenses of any kind incidental to the formation and incorporation of the Company, costs, charges and expenses of negotiating contracts and arrangements made prior to the formation and incorporation of the Company.

18) To amalgamate or merge with/or take over any other institutions having objects substantially similar to the objects of the company on such terms and conditions as may be considered appropriate.

19) To set up Advisory groups, Consultative committees, Working groups or other representative panels or Experts, Advisors, Retainers, Associates, Consultants and soon by the Company in India and Abroad.

20) To secure, collect and provide information to its members and the general public in order to facilitate import from other countries or to export to other countries the products of the members of the Company.

21) To provide for the members a place of meeting so as to enable them to work in consensus to achieve common goals for the overall betterment of their industry and to have a common platform/forum at which they may share their grievances and arrive at solutions. To protect the new education

institution/organizations/entities from persons or entities who can carry on unfair and/or unethical practices or who discredit the entrepreneur's development and their education network.

22) Arranging and providing facilities for conferences, exhibitions, demonstration, lectures, excursions and other functions relating for the attainment of main object of the company and investigating, collecting, and circulating information and statistics

relating to the activities of the company.

23) To maintain close liaison with the central and state government and local authorities generally in connection with matters falling within the scope of the aims and objects of the company and to secure adequate representation for the company of Governments, Semi Governments or other public connected and to subscribe, to become a member of and cooperate with any other company whose objects are altogether or in part similar to those of this company.

24) To organize and establish branches wherever necessary in the opinion of the company and to make the necessary arrangements for the transactions of the business at such places.

25) To commence institute, procure or defend or aid in bringing, prosecuting or defending any suits, actions, proceeding, applications or arbitration on its own accounts or on behalf of the members of the company as the Managing Committee may think proper, expedient or conducive to the objects of the company and to compromise or submit the same to arbitration and to remove all causes of friction and to adjust controversies between persons engaged in the said company.

26) To promote unity, goodwill and friendliness among the members and to preserve, maintain and improve the interests of persons engaged in the said company and to subscribe to any local or other charities and to grant any donation for any public purpose or otherwise and provide superannuation fund to the servants of the company or otherwise assist any such servants or their family.

27) To relive poor and needy members of the company and their wives and families and to

subscribe to, become members of and cooperate with any other company whether incorporated or not whose objects are altogether or in part in the relief of poor and needy persons.

28) To join, to subscribe, to federate or affiliate with other associations, Federations, Exhibition Industries, Chamber Service areas whose objectives are in whole or in part, similar to those of the Association or conducive to the promotion, or the aims and objects of the association.

29) To make Rules and Regulations and Bye-Laws for the conduct of the affairs of the company and to add, amend very or rescind them from time to time.

30) The Profits, if any or other income and property of the company, when so ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

31) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

32) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses.

33) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

34) Nothing in objects shall prevent the payment by the

company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any service (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company. Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or Endeavour to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an of the object of the company, would make it a trade union.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudence remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

9 True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the company and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits and liabilities of the company; and, subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the company for the time being in force, the accounts shall be open to the inspection of the members. 10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.
